Οἶδας Pfall2sg fr. οἶδα
to have information about, know
to possess information about, to know, to know about, to have knowledge of, to be acquainted with, acquaintance

ἀπεστράφησάν API3pl fr. ἀποστρεφω
turn away from by rejecting, reject, repudiate, ‘everybody has turned away from me’ cf. Titus 1:14
to refuse to provide help to someone, to refuse to help, ‘all those in Asia refused to help me’

V. 16

δόνη AAOpt3sg fr. διδωμι
to give something out, give, bestow, grant
to give an object, usually implying value, to give, giving

ἔλεος
kindness or concern expressed for someone in need, mercy, compassion, pity, clemency, may the Lord show kindness to the house of Onesiphorus’
to show kindness or concern for someone in serious need, to show mercy, to be merciful toward, to have mercy on, mercy

οἶκω
household, family
the family consisting of those related by blood and marriage, as well as slaves and servants, living in the same house or homestead, family, household

πολλάκις
pertaining to a number of related points of time, many times, often, frequently
a number of related points of time, often, many times

ἀνέψυξεν AAI3sg fr. ἀναψυχω
to provide relief from obligation or trouble, give someone a breathing space, revive, refresh, ‘he often refreshed me’
to cause someone to recover a state of cheer or encouragement after a time of anxiety and trouble, to encourage, to cheer up, ‘because many times he cheered me up’

ἄλυσίν
chain, generically of imprisonment, cf. Eph. 6:20
the state of being in prison, to be in prison, imprisonment

ἐπαισχύνθη APdepI3sg fr. ἐπαισχυνομαι
to experience a painful feeling or sense of loss of status because of some particular event or activity, be ashamed
to experience or feel shame or disgrace because of some particular event or activity, to be ashamed of

γενόμενος AMdepPtcpMSN fr. γινομαι
to be in or at a place, be in, be there
to be in a place, with the possible implication of having come to be in such a place, to be (in a place)

σπουδαίως
pertaining to being conscientious in discharging a duty or obligation, diligently, earnestly, zealously, cf. Titus 3:13
pertaining to intense effort in accomplishing some goal, making an effort to, doing one's best

ἐζήτησέν AAI3sg fr. ζητεω
try to find something, seek, look for in order to find, what one desires somehow to bring into relation with oneself or to obtain without knowing where it is to be found
to try to learn the location of something, often by movement from place to place in the process of searching, to try to learn where something is, to look for, to try to find

εὑρεν AAI3sg fr. εὕρισκω
to come upon something either through purposeful search or accidentally, find, after seeking, find, discover, come upon
to learn the location of something, either by intentional searching or by unexpected discovery, to learn the whereabouts of something, to find, to discover, to come upon, to happen to find

δόη AAOpt3sg fr. διδωμι
see above

εὐρεῖν AAInf fr. εὕρισκω
to attain a state or condition, find (for oneself), obtain, 'obtain mercy from the Lord'
to begin to experience an event or state, to begin to experience, to come into an experience, to attain

ἔλεος

παρὰ
marker of one who originates or directs, from
marker of the agentive source of an activity, though often remote and indirect, from, by, of

ὅσα

pertaining to a comparative quantity or number of objects, or events; how much (many), as much (many) as

a degree of correlative extent, to the degree that, to the same degree, as much as

διηκόνησεν

AAI3sg

fr. διακονεω

to perform obligations, without focus on intermediary function, of unspecified services, perform duties, render assistance, serve, 'what services he rendered'

to render assistance or help by performing certain duties, often of a humble or menial nature, to serve, to render service, to help, service, help

βέλτιον

pertaining to being relatively superior, better, 'know very well'

pertaining to events which measure up to their intended purpose, fine, well, good, excellent, well done, 'you know very well'
