



Discussion Questions for Week 9



From “09 – The Missionary Movement”

1. What did you learn from the Missionary Movement? What stood out? How does this apply?

What did you learn from the Missionary Movement that will help you be a better witness for Christ? Describe something that stood out to you as insightful and/or inspirational. Why did that stand out to you, and why do you think it is important? In what ways did it inspire you to be a better witness? What principles did you learn that will help you to do so? Is there anything that stood out as a warning of what to avoid doing? If so, what and why? And how do you intend to apply this insight in your own life and ministry?

2. How can you contextualize without compromise? What principles can you learn from the Missionary Movement? How does it apply?

What have you learned from the history of the missionaries of this time period, that will help you to understand and apply the concept of contextualized without compromise? How can the church contextualize the Gospel without compromising into syncretism? What are some examples you have seen, which model what to do well? What are some examples of what not to do? Ideally, how should this work out cross culturally? And what should it look like in your own culture? What examples and insights can you learn from and follow in your own context? And how do you intend to live out this idea and guard against possible mistakes?
