Title:

Exodus- literally “a road out [of Egypt]”

Hebrew Title- “[These are the] Names” (1:1)

Author:

Anonymous, attributed to Moses

Occasion and Purpose:

Written at the Exodus for the new nation to understand their identity, heritage and responsibility.

A polemic against false Gods, showing that the God of Israel is the one true God.

Narrating God’s revelation of Himself through the mighty acts of the Exodus and the creation of the covenant people.

Themes:

1. The NAME
2. Deliverance/Rescue
3. Covenant
4. God’s presence with His people

Summary:

The story of God's rescuing the nation of Israel from Egypt and creating a nation out of this family. Through the miraculous plagues and the leadership of Moses, the nation of Israel left Egypt and camped in the desert. Then God entered into a covenant with them to make them a special nation for Himself. He gave them the law in the form of the Ten Commandments and other laws as a way for them to live in holiness with Him and He gave them the design for the tabernacle as His dwelling place among them.
