## Author:

Zephaniah, son of Cushi. Zephaniah was a great- grandson of King Hezekiah. Zephaniah means “The Lord hides”.

## Occasion and Purpose:

Possibly an invasion was the occasion of the call to repentance and to seek the Lord for mercy.

## Themes:

1. Judgment and Salvation
2. Day of the Lord

## Summary:

Zephaniah speaks of the coming final wrath of God, called the "day of the Lord." He also speaks of the mercy to get people through this wrath and encourages men to seek God for his mercy in times of coming judgment.
